**SUBJECT:** Conflict Minerals Sourcing Policy

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Dodd-Frank Act requires all US publicly traded companies to file disclosures and reports with the US Securities and Exchange Commission related to the use of conflict minerals in their products.

Conflict materials are defined as;  
Cassiterite – (Tin) Example: solder  
Columbite – Tantalite or Coltan (Tantalum) Example: electronics  
Wolframite – (Tungsten) Example: electrodes  
Gold – Example: electronics

Jefferson Electric does not directly source or process conflict minerals. Tin may be contained in our products in the form of solder used during manufacturing.

We have received responses the majority of our suppliers to allow us to complete the industry standard Conflict Mineral Reporting Template (CMRT).
